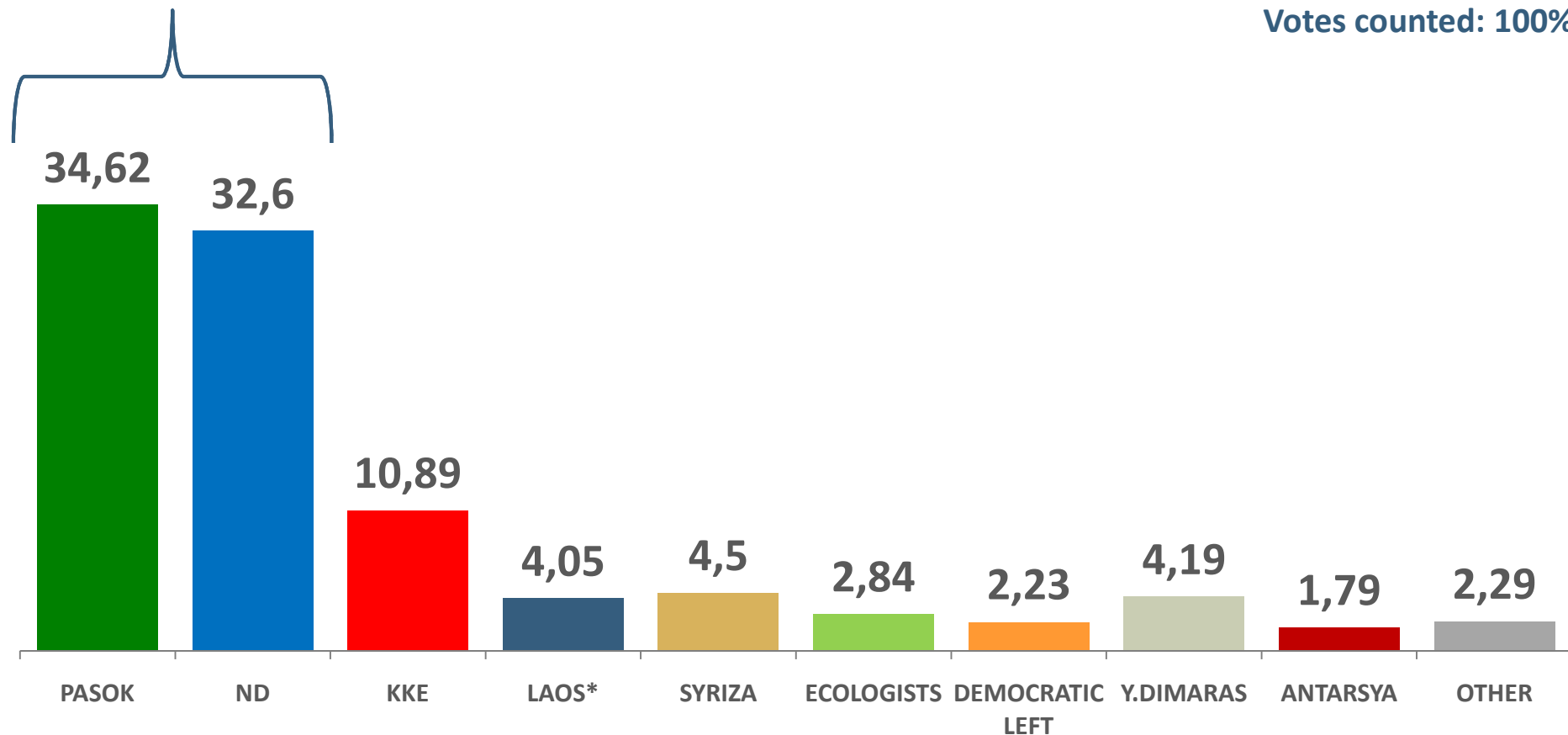

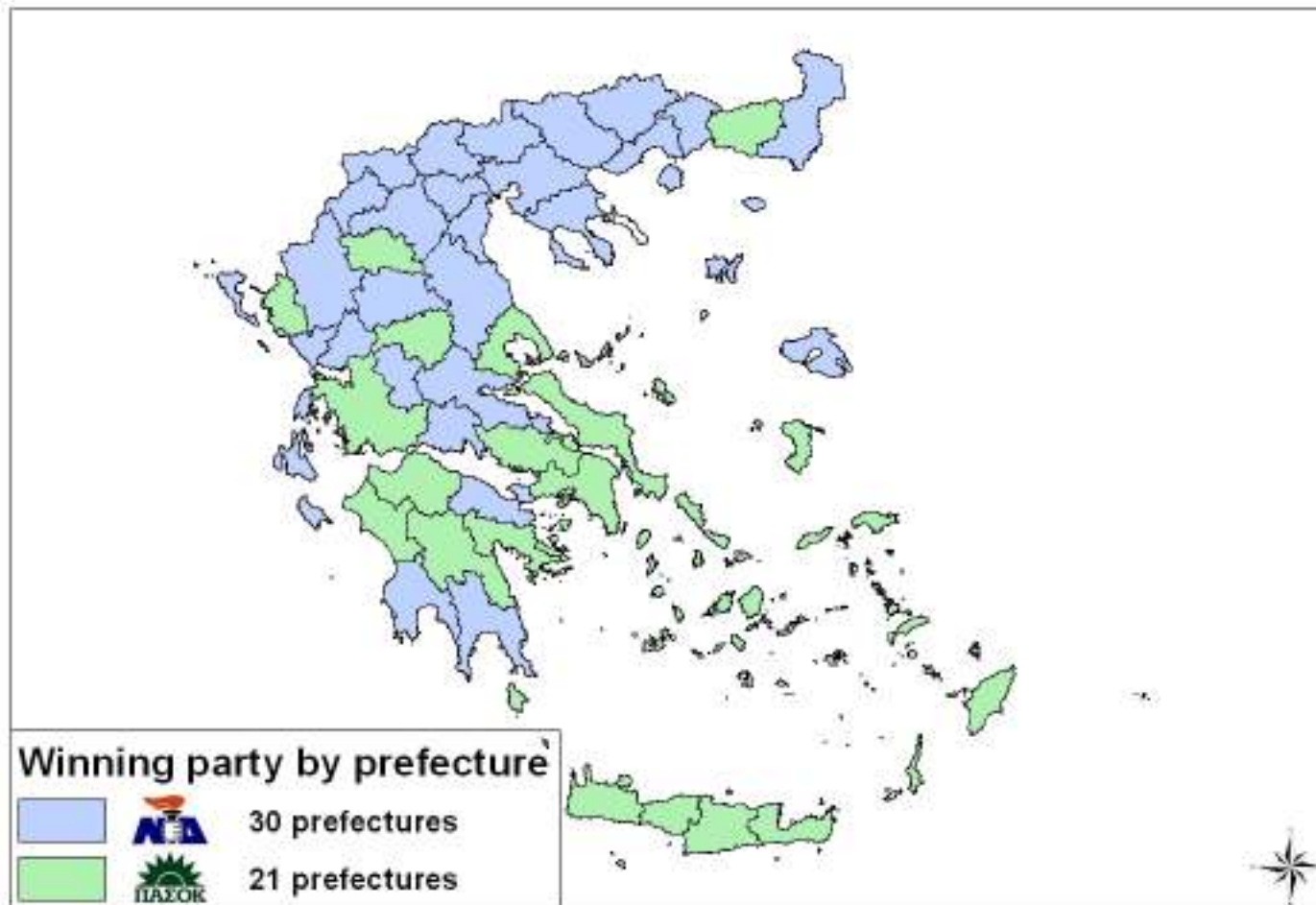

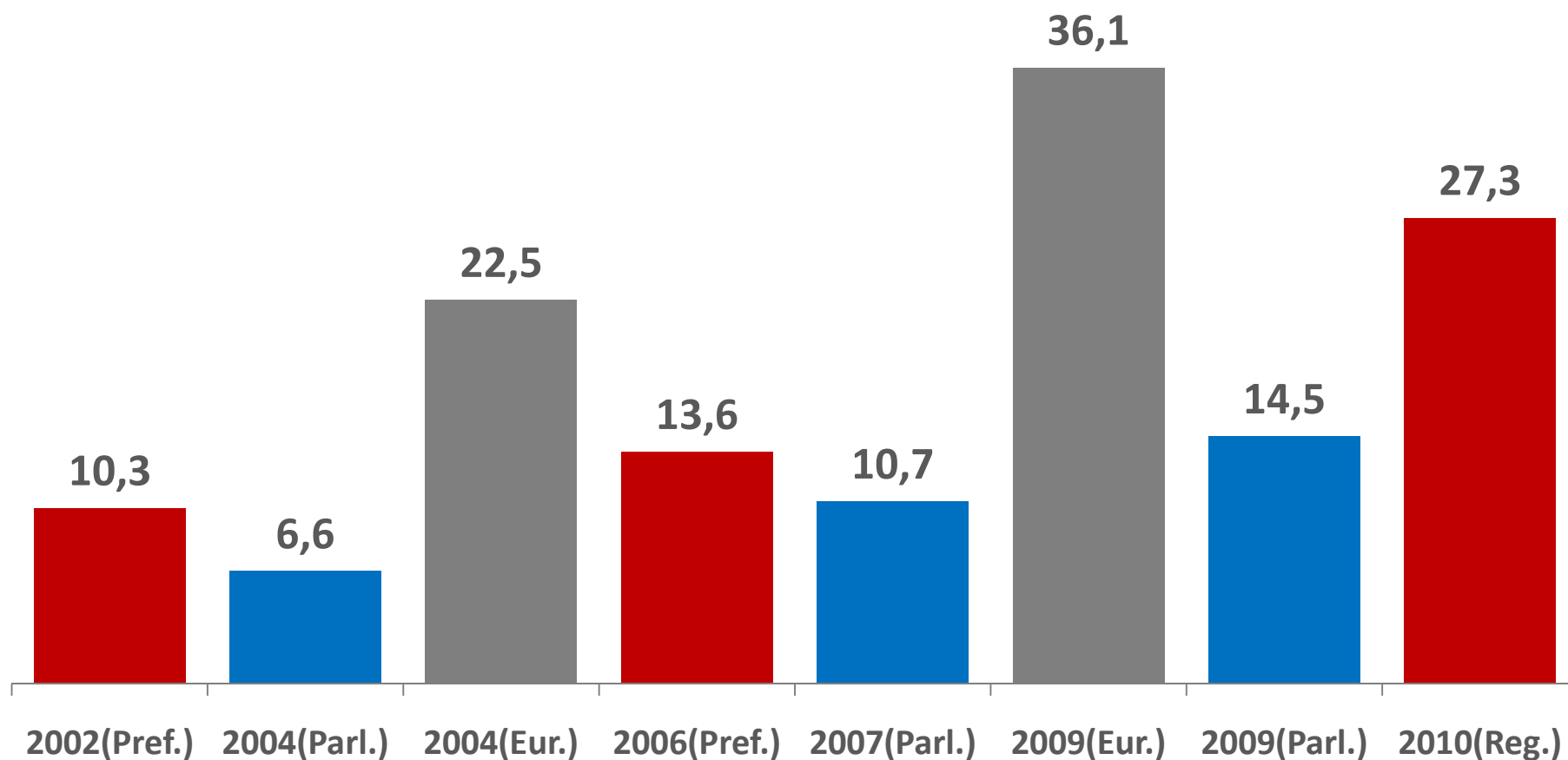
2. WINNING PARTY BY ELECTORAL DISTRICT

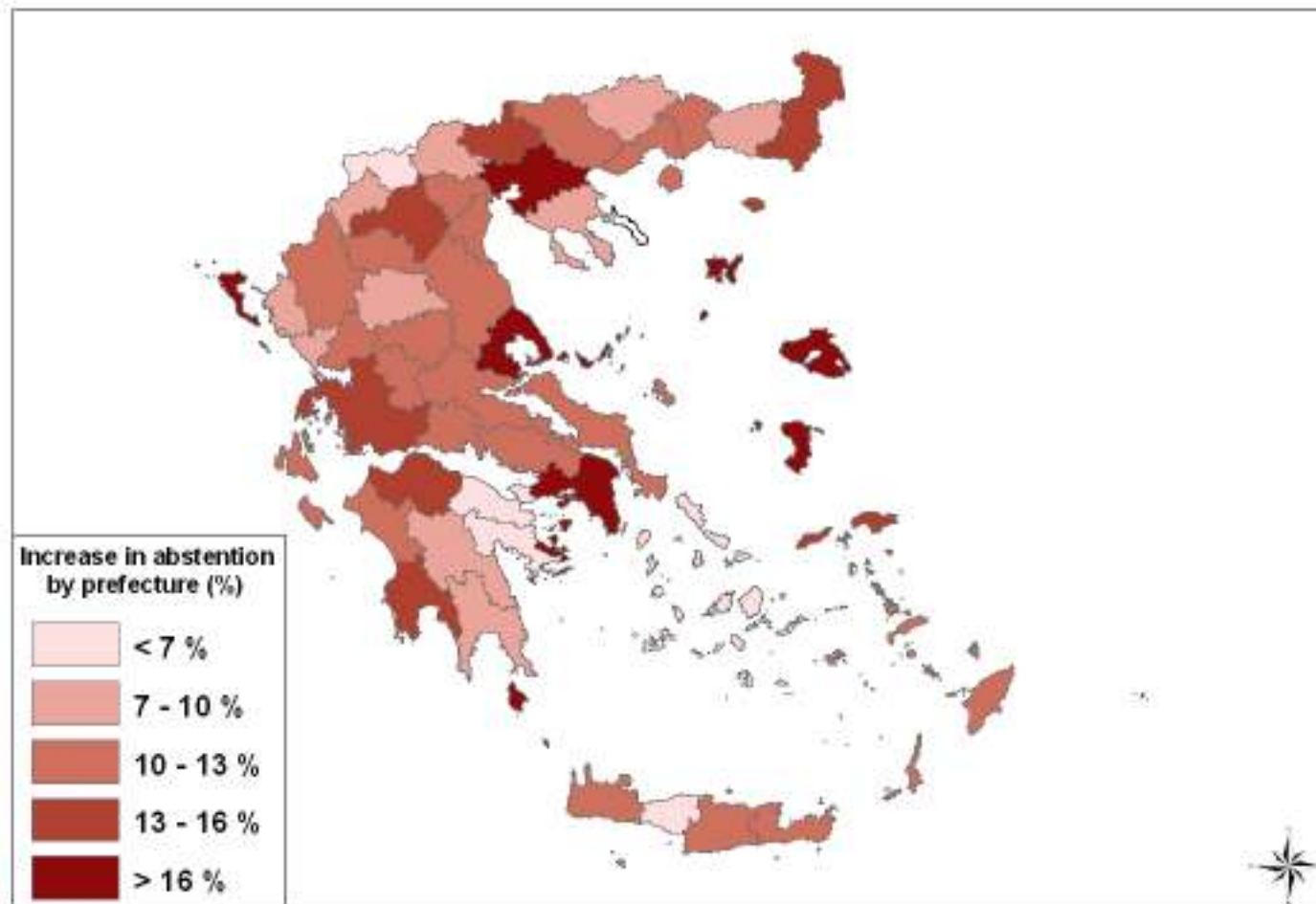

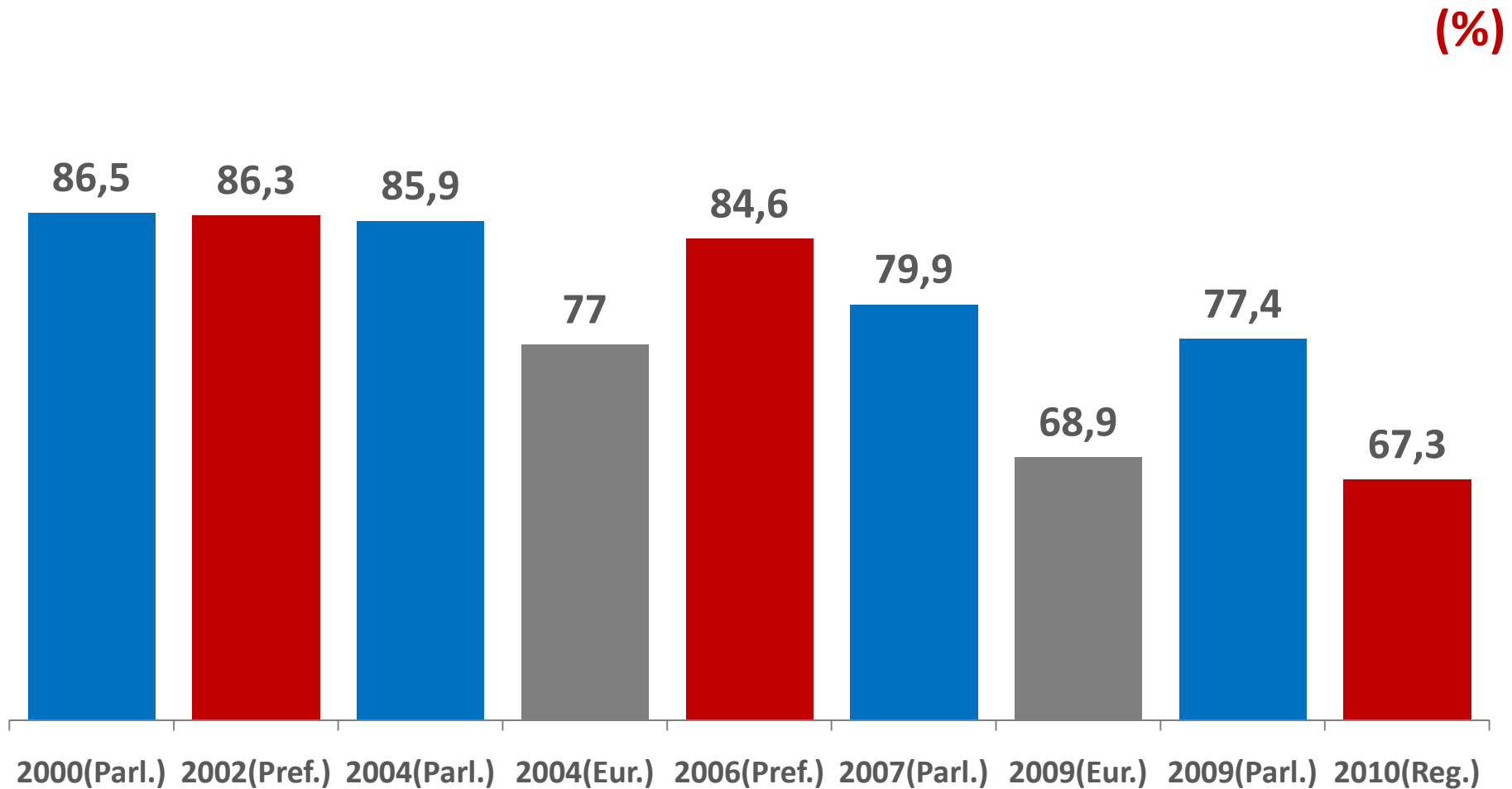
